

	A country forming the northernmost part of the United Kingdom and containing the capital, Edinburgh.
	A country of the United Kingdom, to the west of central England, and containing the capital Cardiff.
	A province of the United Kingdom that occupies the north-eastern part of Ireland, comprised of six counties of Ulster, and containing the capital Belfast.
	A diagram of an area of land or sea, showing physical and human features.
	A nation with its own government, occupying a particular territory.
	The place that functions as the seat of government and administrative centre of a country.
	The sea channel separating southern England from northern France
